## Summer Camp Guidelines

#### Welcome to GymEtc summer camp!

First, we would like to say thank you for choosing GymEtc for your childcare needs. The GymEtc summer camp program has been providing children with fun filled days for over 10 years. Activities include gymnastics, cheerleading, games, arts & crafts, field trips, and more. Our facility features boys and girls Olympic equipment, a 40' trampoline, and is overseen by qualified professionals. Both are USAG members (USA-gymnastics) and have USAG safety certifications.

#### **Times & Fees**

Half day - 9:00 - 12:00 or 12:00 - 4:00 \$15.00 per day or \$50.00 per week

Full day - 7:30 - 6:00 \$30.00 per day or \$80.00 per week

#### **Late Pickup or Payment**

\$1.00 per minute after 6:05, \$2.00 per minute after the 3<sup>rd</sup> late pickup

Payment is due on the Monday of the current week. Payments made after Tuesday will be considered late and a \$10.00 late fee will be charged.

#### **Lunches**

Children under the age of 8 will have lunch from 12:00 - 1:00. Children 8 and older will have lunch from 1:00 - 2:00. Children will need a bag lunch. They **do not** have access to a microwave or a refrigerator, they are for staff only. Please provide all the necessary eating utensils and condiments for your child's lunch.

It is required that all children bring a bag for their personal belongings. Because left over clothing is an overwhelming problem, all items left in lost & found will be donated to the Salvation Army every other Friday. Also, children are encouraged to keep their socks in their shoes to prevent any loss.

#### **Game Boys, Cell Phones, & other Electronics**

Children are allowed to bring game boys and other electronic games to the gym, with limited use. Children bring their games and other belongings at their own risk. Anything of considerable value is better left at home. Children are allowed to bring and use cell phones, but only at designated times with staff's permission.

**Medication**

If your child requires any medication, please complete a consent form for administration of medication. Any medication left at the gym at the end of summer camp will be discarded.

**Hair**

We ask that any child with shoulder length hair or longer to wear their hair up (pony tail, bun, etc). Hair brushes are not allowed in the gym and students should do their hair before arriving at the gym. Children are not allowed to do each other's hair while at the gym. Also, no sharing or doing makeup or nails at the gym.

**Disabilities**

Please inform the gym of any emotional, learning, or physical disabilities your child may have so the staff can better prepare to work with your child.

**Money & Concession**

Children may bring money to the gym for concession. It is recommended that children purchase concession cards to prevent any lost money. Parents can set spending limits on concession cards and can also monitor purchases.

**Gymnastic Rotations**

GymEtc has between 6 and 8 gymnastic rotations per week. The rotations are about 40 minutes long and all children are required to participate. If for some reason your child can not participate, please send a note. Any child not participating in rotations will not be allowed to participate in any physical activities for that day.

**Field Trips**

All field trips are optional. However, our field trip t-shirt and bag is required if children want to participate. On most Wednesdays, we will be taking a field trip to Simpson pool. Children will need to bring their swimsuit, sunscreen, and their bag for wet clothes. Due to high levels of chlorine, it is recommended that children bring goggles to the pool. Other field trips include bowling, skating, and movies, and children will be required to wear their field trip t-shirt in these trips. Parents will always be notified in advance before any field trip.
